An **Operation Nightingale** and **Breaking Ground Heritage** collaboration investigating and excavating the site of a Napoleonic era fortification that was last used until in the late 19th Century as a gunnery school. The site also has a darker past as we have already conducted the recovery of five bodies buried deep in the depths of the island possibly Prisoners of War or Convict burials.

This excavation will also comprise of several field trips to contemporary sites in the area to give participants a greater depth of knowledge of what else might have been going on during this turbulent period of British history.
